

Dr. A. Chavan, Professor of Radiology, Klinikum Oldenburg, Germany

Brief Curriculum Vitae

After completing his MD Radiology in India, Dr. A Chavan migrated to Germany and commenced his advanced training in Radiology at the Hannover Medical School in 1991, where he was put in charge of Interventional Radiology in 1993. He was largely instrumental in developing this speciality at the Hannover Medical School. He has done extensive clinical and research work in the fields of chemoembolization of hepatic tumors, renal angioplasty, interventional treatment of vascular malformations as well as the minimal invasive therapy of aortic aneurysms and aortic dissections. He passed his German Board Examination for Radiology in 1996, after which he was appointed as Consultant in Radiology at the Hannover Medical School. He was awarded his Associate Professorship in 2001 (for his animal experimental work on suprarenal fixation of aortic stent-grafts) and Full Professorship of Radiology in 2008. Prof. Chavan has been instrumental in establishing stent grafting for aortic aneurysms and aortic dissections in various institutions in Germany, Austria, Israel, India and Singapore. Together with Prof. A. Haverich (Dept. of Cardiothoracic Surgery, Hannover Medical School), he has developed a hybrid endograft for intra-operative implantation in patients with extensive thoracic aortic aneurysms and dissections, which reduces the two step-surgery necessary in such patients to a single-step procedure. He assumed duties as Head of the Department of Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology in Klinikum Oldenburg, a teaching hospital affiliated to the University of Göttingen, in 2004.
